



Last week's uptick in lumber prices saw solid follow-through in all species. Mills found success increasing prices and bumping order files, in some cases out into mid-February. Brokers drove much of that business based on increased offerings this week. Panels saw solid activity as well. OSB prices perked up again with additional news that a second major supplier claimed to be adjusting available cash volumes down through the first quarter. Next week will be a solid indicator of whether this is a quick feed at the trough, or the start of an actual run.
