



Commodity markets took a hard turn this week as the supply side appeared to tighten on news of curtailments, mainly in OSB. Two large mills in the SE announced varying degrees of down time, with one closing indefinitely and another pulling half of it's capacity down for a significant amount of time as well. GDF markets, which began climb again last week, continued to rise. SPF and SYP markets have followed suit. Enough business was done to push order files well into November.
