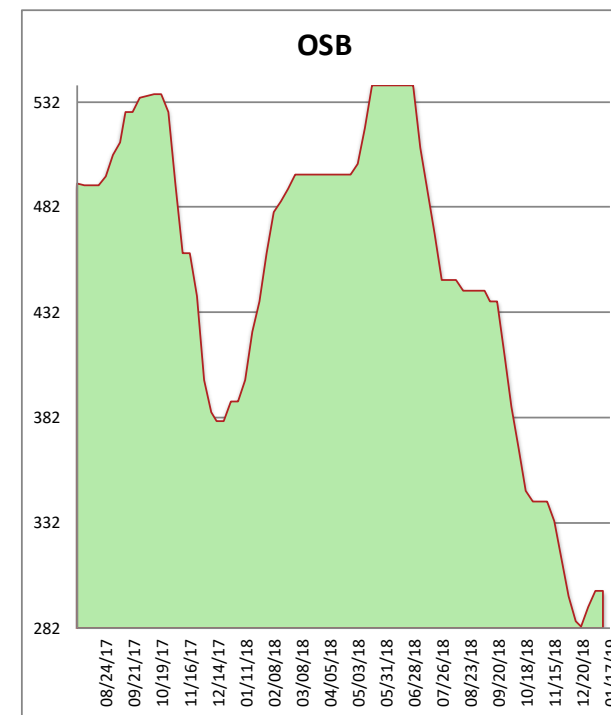
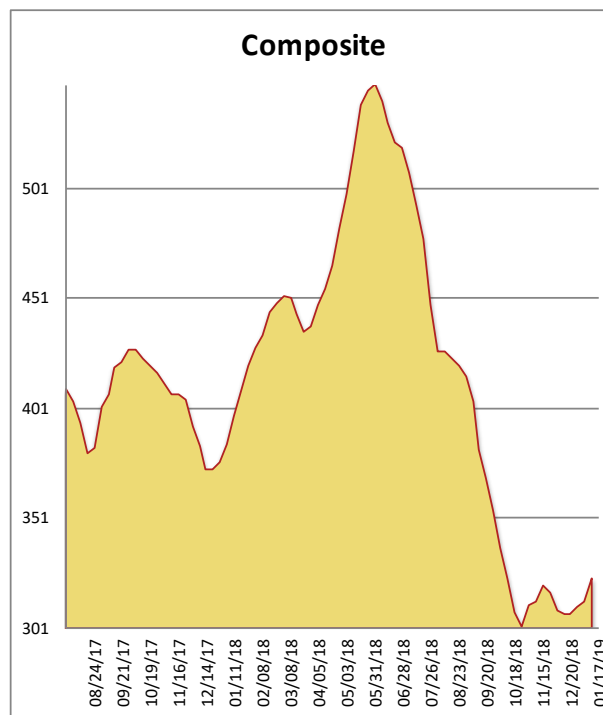

DF, HF, and SYP followed SPF's lead, with buyers coming in to cover some immediate needs only. OSB activity picked up later in the week when a large producer announced that they would be reducing the amount of open market product available in Q1. Our demand that the border wall be built of wood continues to go ignored.
