



Mills continued to struggle moving lumber into a market that seems to have enough wood for the time being. W-SPF and dry DF seem to be struggling the most as ample supply out of Canada is keeping the market soft on those species. Canfor announced a temporary curtailment at their 13 mills that will pull some supply out of play for a couple of weeks in early May. If more of these come along, the market will respond. OSB could use some curtailments as well. Watch for it.
