



Commodity markets were relatively quiet coming out of the Thanksgiving holiday break. News that the CN rail strike got resolved took some of the spark out of the market and winter weather became a bigger factor in much of the country. Mills fell back on order files and looked at only the smallest of counters. DF in both dry and green dimension remain the strongest specie, while SYP and SPF seem to be more susceptable to lower prices. OSB was lackluster across all regions, though some buyers expressed concerns that open market wood could tighten as the 2019 contract year ends.
