



Markets remain strong in terms of shipments to jobsites this week. Mills continue to ride order files that carry them through June and into July, but there is some pause now by buyers at these levels. The torrid pace of takeaway from the big box stores remains a key driver, especially on treated lumber. Delays are the norm on most treated orders now. SYP narrows have reached a peak, and SPF is also poised to give back. OSB is two-tiered, with brokers and wholesalers undercutting mills. 8 foot studs in all dimensions are super hot and hard to come by.
