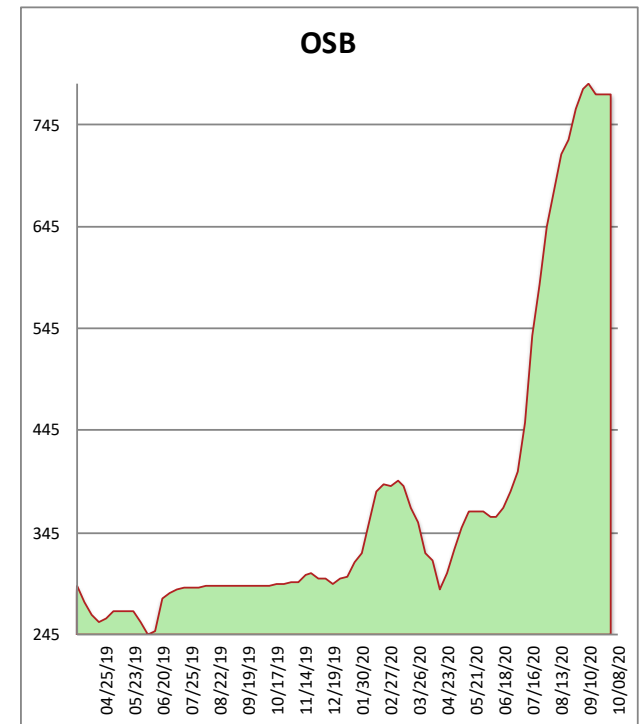
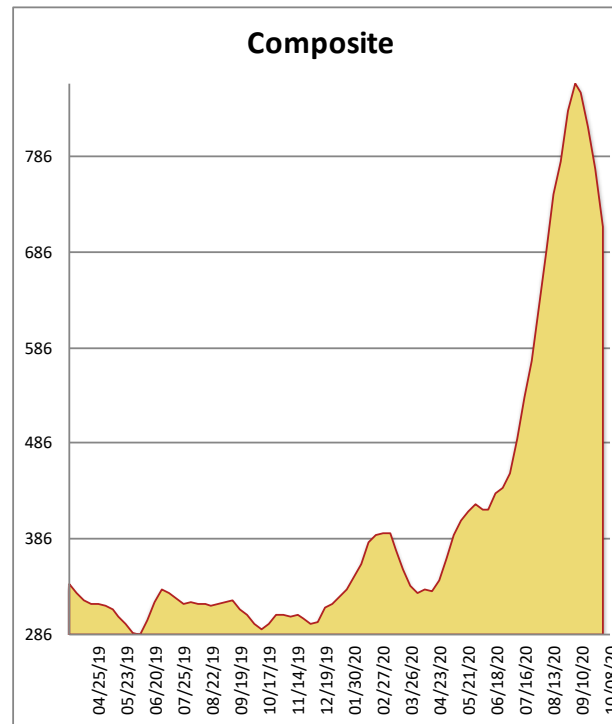

Fissures in SPF and SYP dimension widened as buyers stuck largely to the sidelines and watched the market soften. Green DF finally gave back after months of price gains. Reports that DF salvage logs are stacked and ready to haul to the mills in fire plagued Oregon has buyers watching for added supply and downward pressure on dry DF in the near future. SYP plywood is dropping, but OSB appears to be dug in at record high levels as mills report three week order files. Buyers in the South are keeping a close eye on Hurricane Delta, expected to strike the Gulf Coast on the same path as Laura did six weeks ago. Twenty-six days until what will no doubt be a contentious election.
