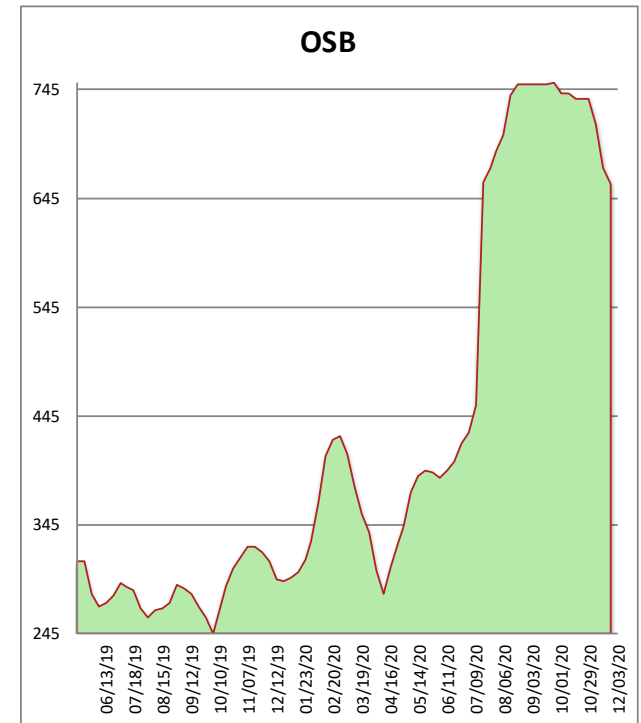
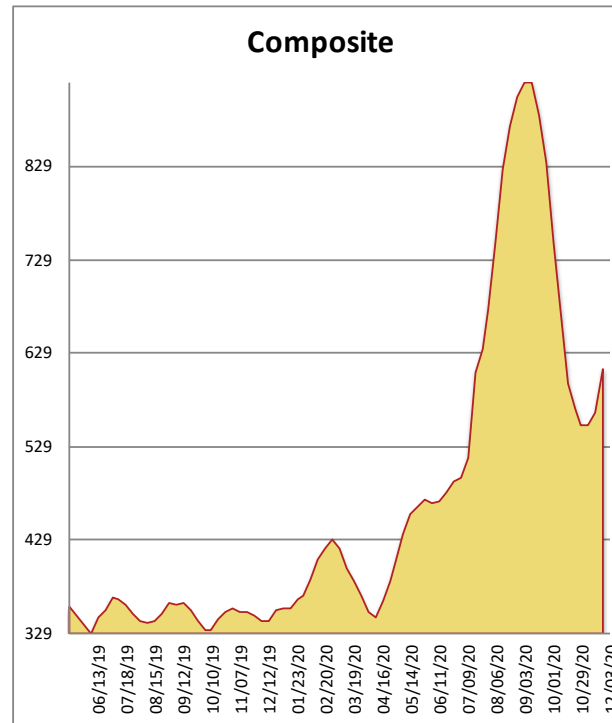

Activity remains robust as we roll into December. Inventories that have been lean all year at the dealer and secondary levels still have not changed much. Prices continue to rise across the board in both lumber and in panels, and December order files are disappearing. Trucking challenges have increased, creating delays and adding to the sense of urgency in the field. 2020 is going out like the lion it was all year, and 2021 will begin with the same dynamics - plenty of demand and very tight supply. Unless weather significantly slows construction, we are in for more of the same in Q1.
