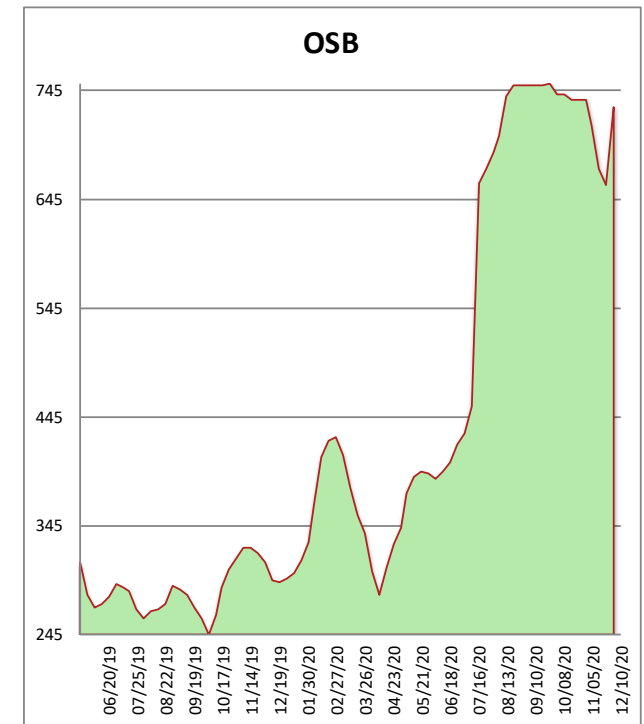
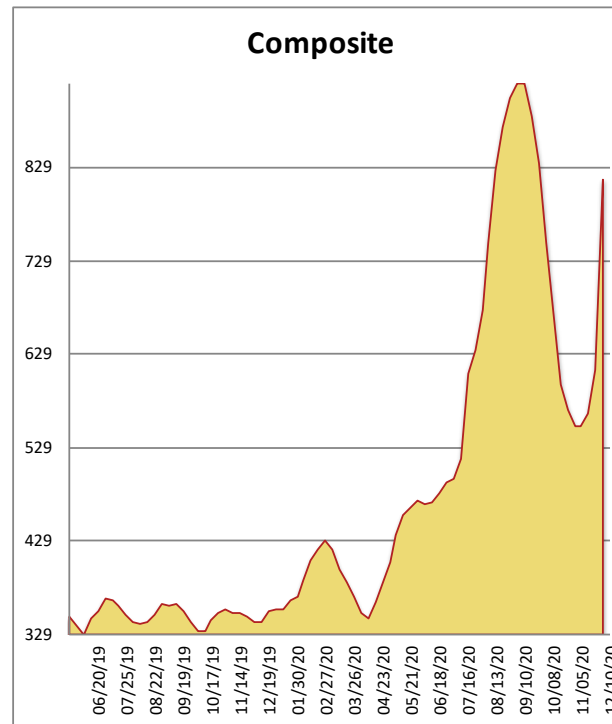

OSB in the west and studs are red hot, as is SYP and SPF dimension lumber. Western plywood jumped hard on the heels of OSB. This market is not for the faint of heart. Holiday curtailments and trucking issues are only adding to the upward momentum.
