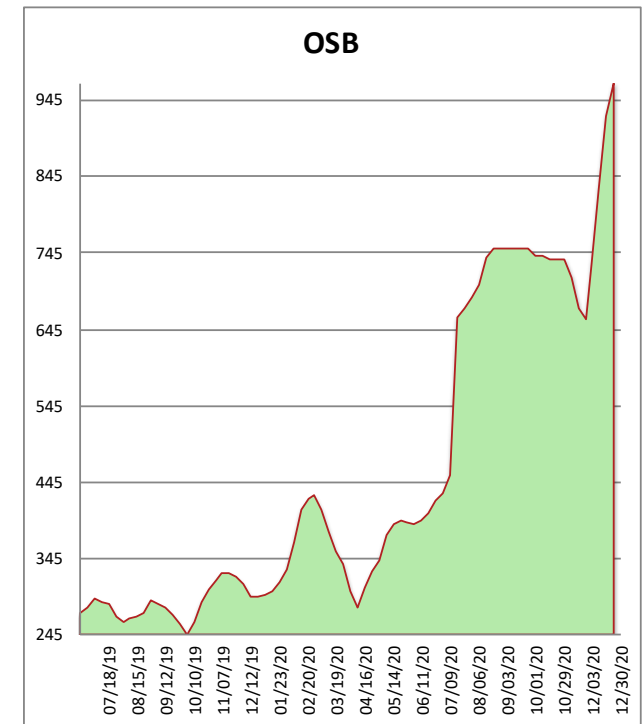
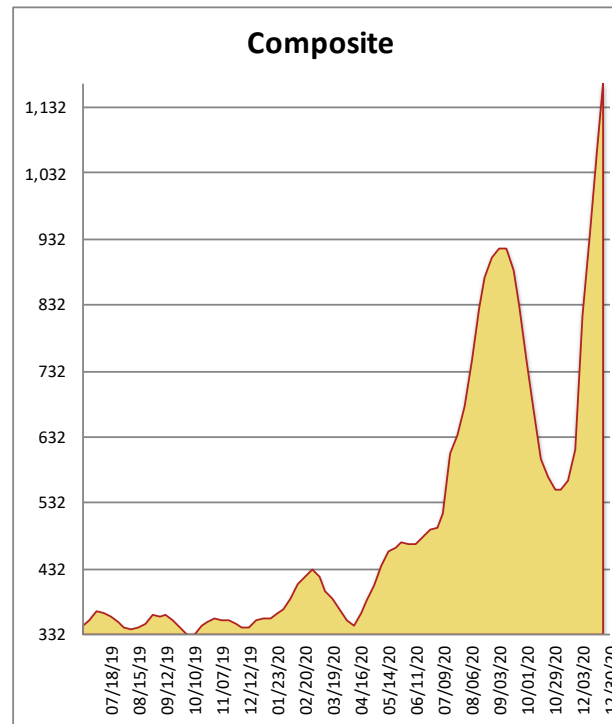

Another holiday-shortened week saw limited participation as traders took time off to end a very challenging 2020, but that did not keep the market from continuing its run. SYP dimension, in particular, saw substantial increases as buyers needing prompt wood paid top dollar for anything they could find. Other lumber items rose as well, but not at the pace of SYP. OSB continues to be hot and hard to source. Weather that is packing a one-two punch for much of the eastern side of the country may slow the pace in the coming weeks, but mills can easily ride long order files into the start of February. Covid continues to negatively impact production.
