






Mills have gotten the upper hand with order files largely now into 2022. Studs have been white hot in all species, and lumber is up across the board. Plywood has heated up and is pulling OSB along for the ride. Weather has been mild across much of the country, keeping demand very strong. Where we have had weather in Western Canada it has only served to flood railroads and highways, creating shipment delays. Don't expect any price relief in December or likely even January - they are cooked drier than that turkey you ate a week ago.
