



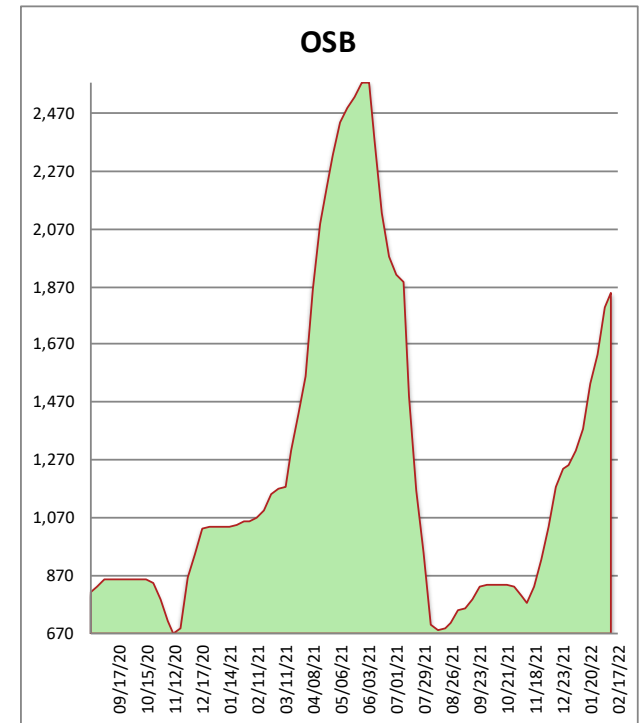
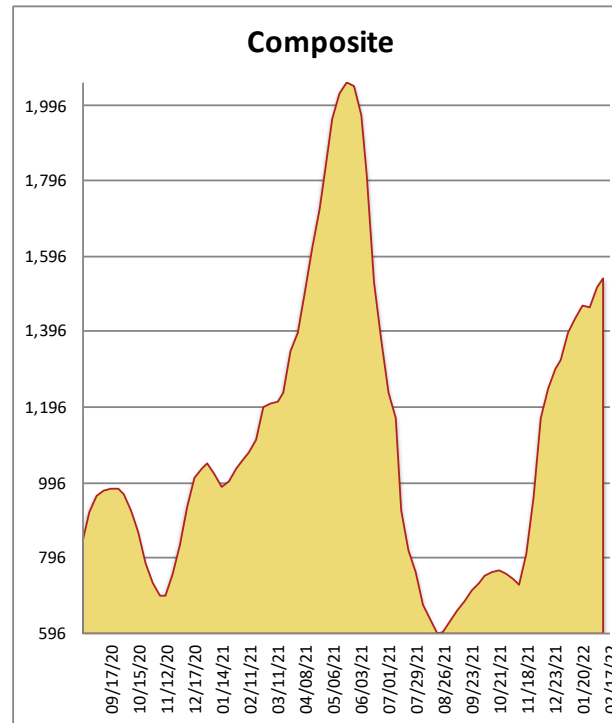

Plywood prices are climbing higher as buyers shift from elusive and high-priced OSB. Imported OSB out of Eastern Europe has helped fill the void, but what happens if Russia invades Ukraine? Reports that treaters are increasing SYP dimension and plywood purchases has buyers concerned that relief is nowhere near.
