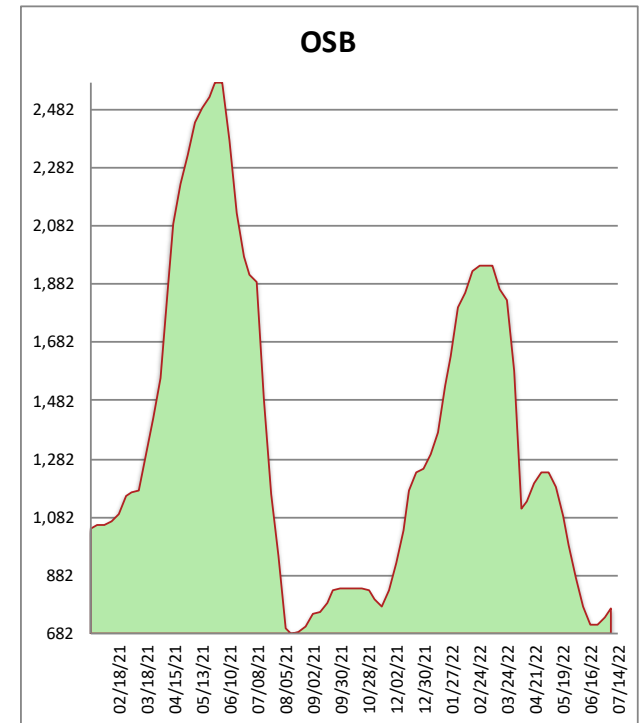
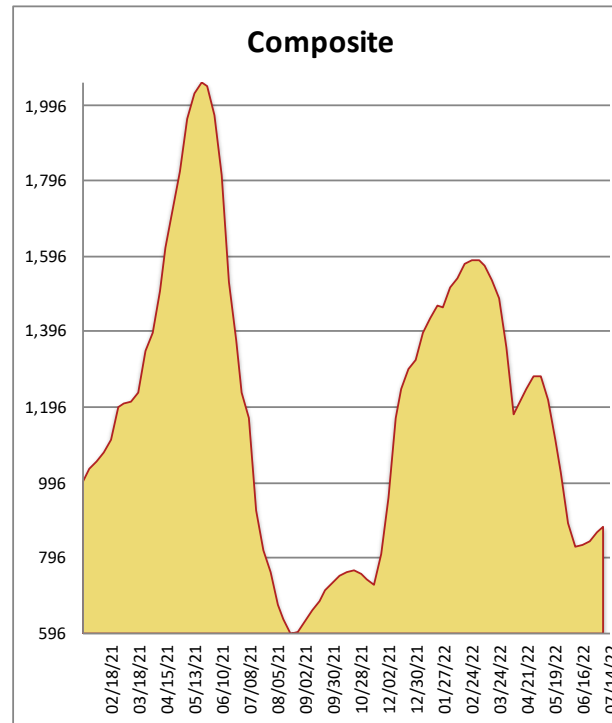

With summer season in full swing, markets stayed on the upswing at a moderate pace. Jobsite activity remains brisk, though triple-digit heat is shortening the work day in southern markets. SYP and SPF narrows are leading the lumber charge, as are nine-foot stud trims. OSB is still on the upswing, with plywood sales perking up in both fir and SYP. The Inland Lumber gathering in North Idaho pulled numerous mill sales people and their buyers away this week. Thus far the pace of the bounce has been reasonable, but fire season and hurricane season are primed to potentially impact the markets. Don't get caught napping!
