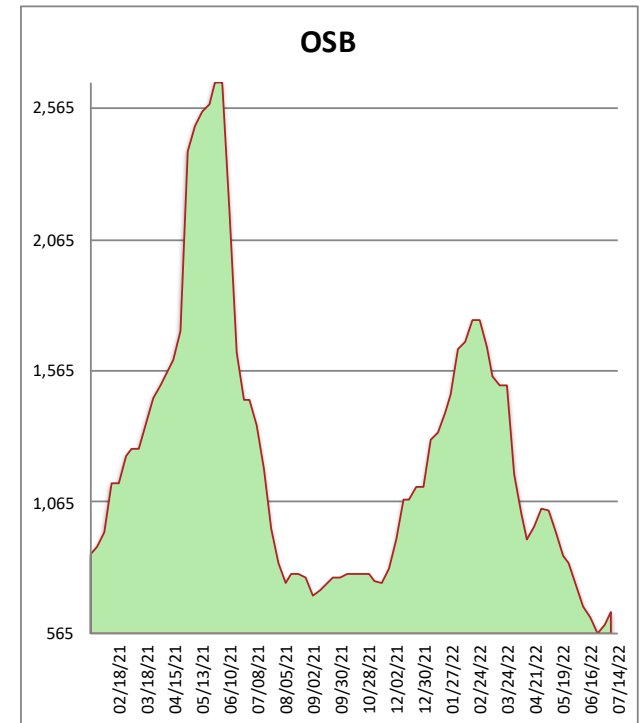
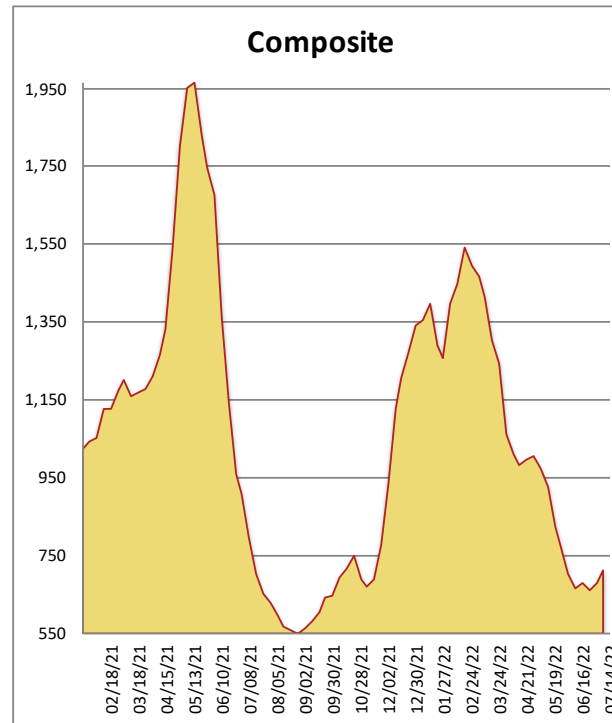

SYP and SPF narrows are leading the lumber charge, as are nine-foot stud trims. OSB is still on the upswing, with plywood sales perking up in both fir and SYP. The Inland Lumber gathering in North Idaho pulled numerous mill sales people and their buyers away this week.
