





Western SPF saw the biggest price gains as buyers rushed in to cover needs before mills aggressively raised quotes. Green DF also saw some strong gains early in the week as producers captured double digit increases. OSB remained quiet while Southern plywood continued to see lower prices on most thicknesses.
