

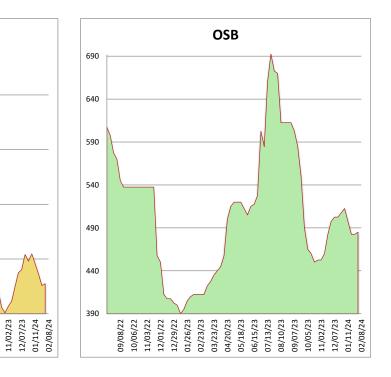

DF studs were a bright spot moving up on a curtailment announcement LW. Futures drifted backwards as the week went on, adding to the tepid pace. OSB in the south traded sideways while Northern Board bounced off a bottom late in the week, and firmed with several mills finding levels to attract enough orders to clear out any excess wood.
