



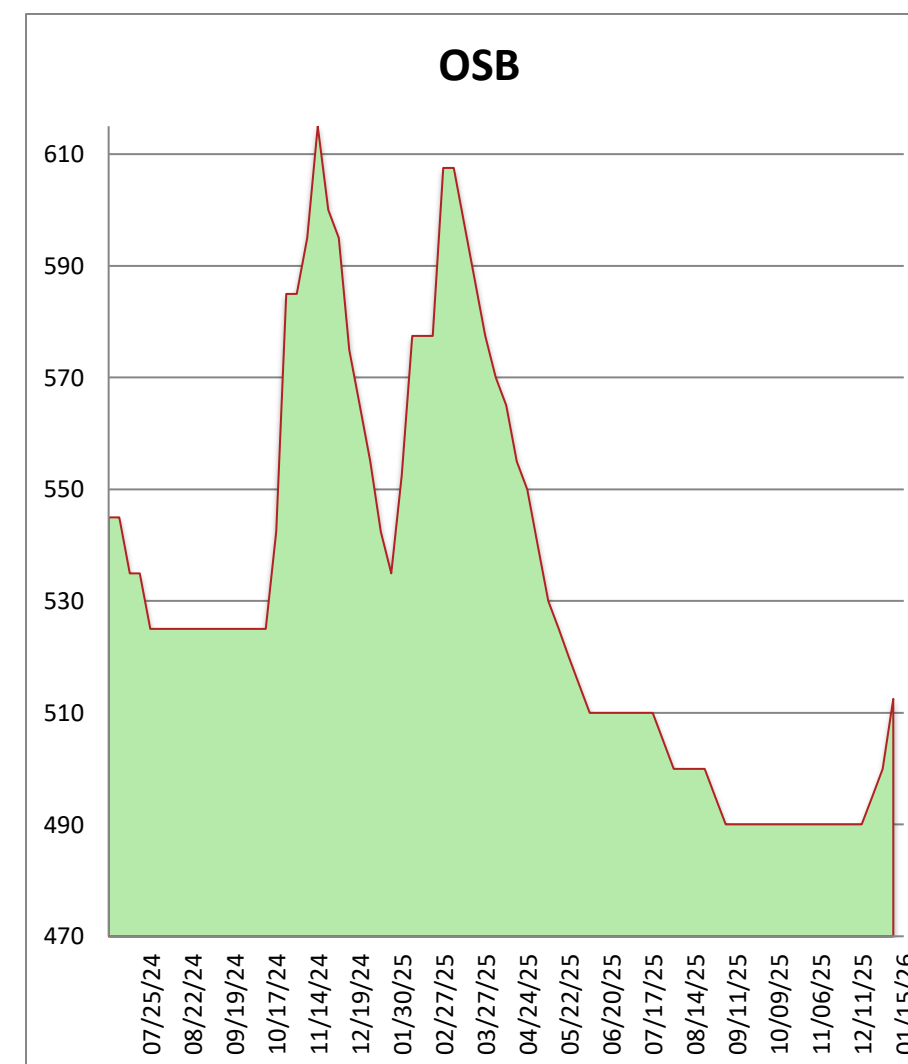
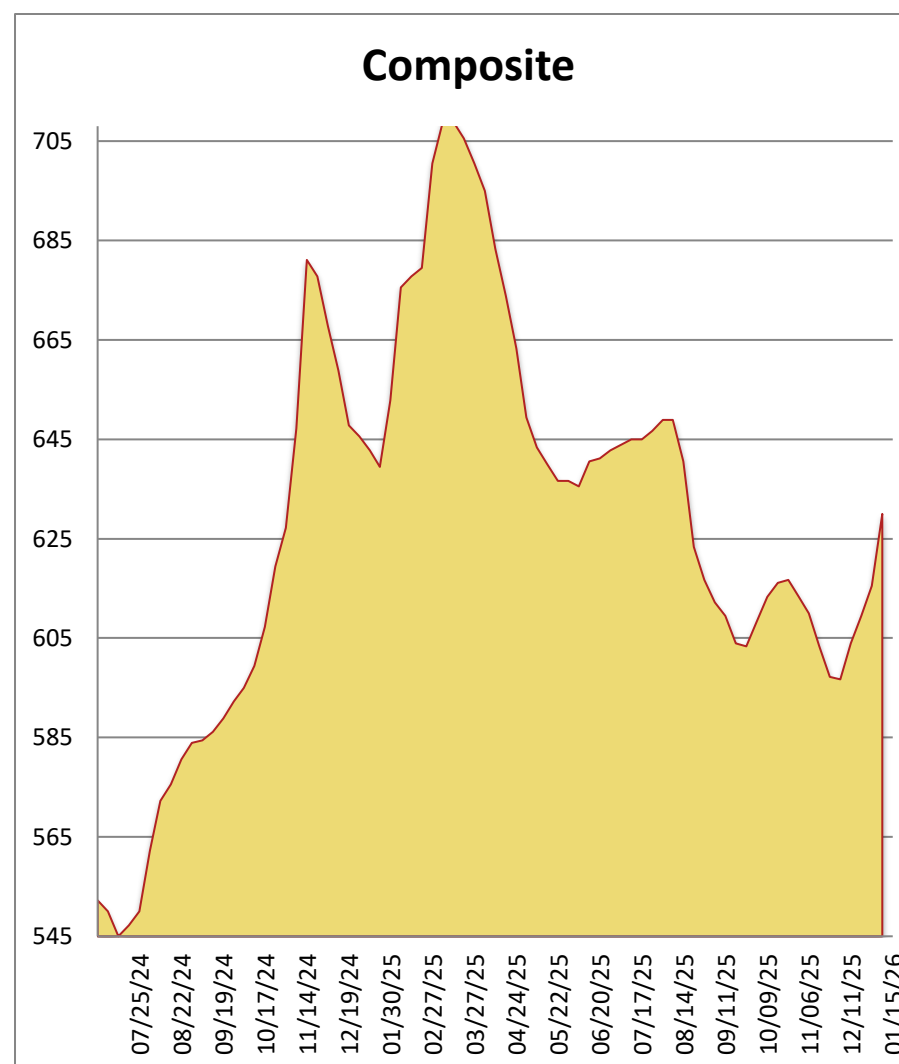

A fire at a Canadian mill helped buoy the mindset in SPF that supply could remain tight. Studs appear to be toppy at the moment as sales volumes slowed week over week. Plywood sales remain stable but uneventful, showing little to no price appreciation. OSB has seen some upward momentum in southern markets, but winter weather in the Midwest and in northern markets tell a different story in terms of activity and price. We have another weekend of hopefully good football ahead in both college and pro games.
