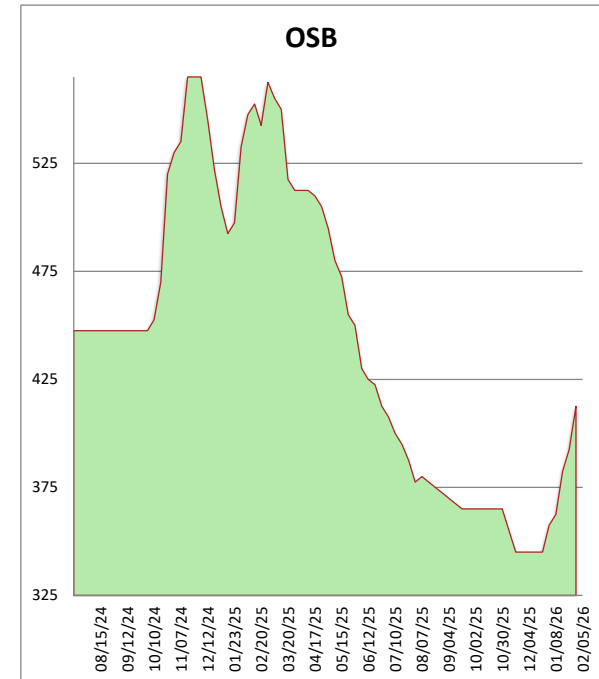
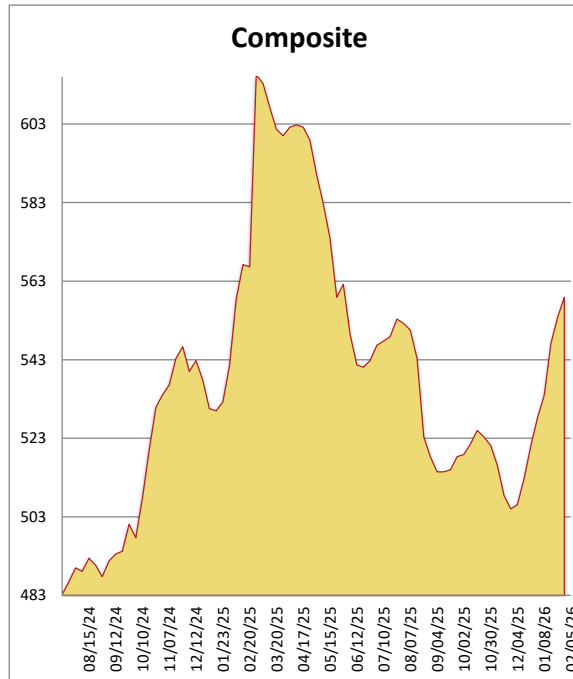

Markets continued to trade in a fairly tight range with mills finding just enough takeaway to keep production from surpassing demand. Weather continued to be a key factor across a large portion of the South. Jobsite were slow to thaw out and return to a normal production schedule. In the West, continued abnormally warm/dry weather have kept jobsites active, but historically slower takeaway in Jan/Feb has kept demand somewhat muted. On the lumber side KD and GRN 9' trims continue to be a bright spot with double digit increases.
