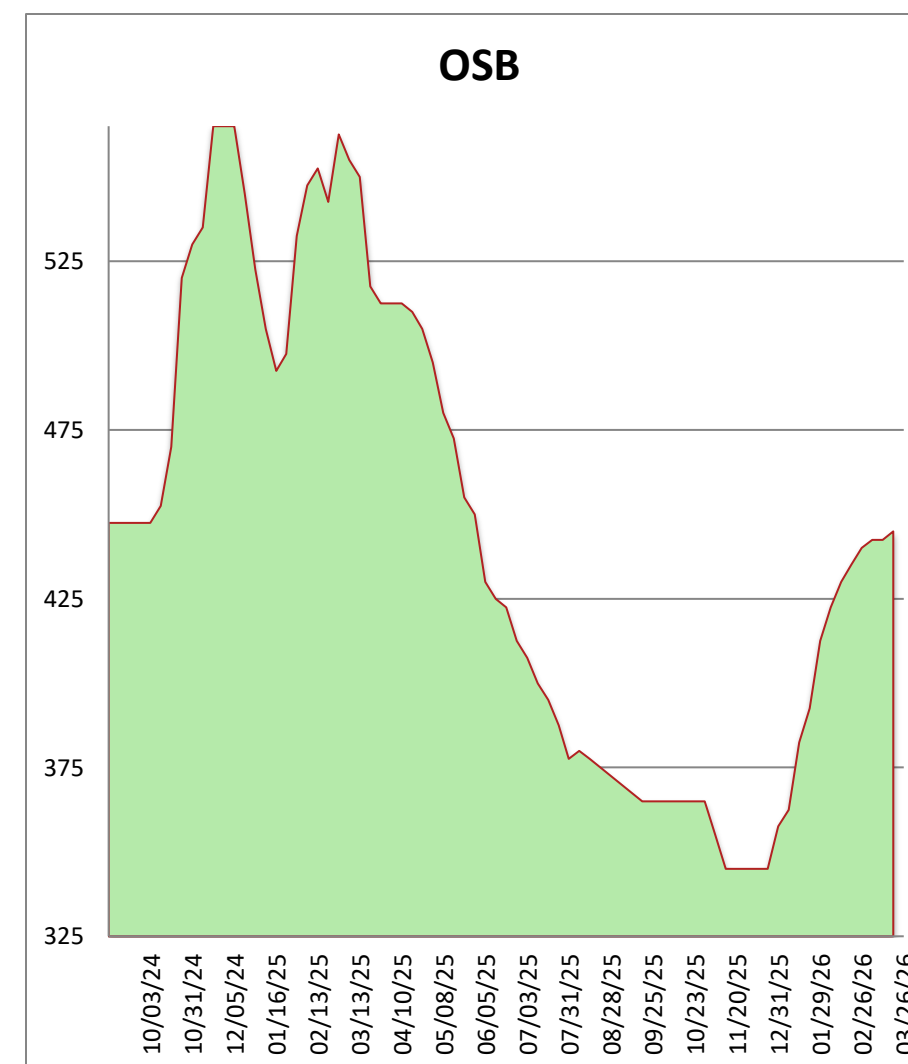
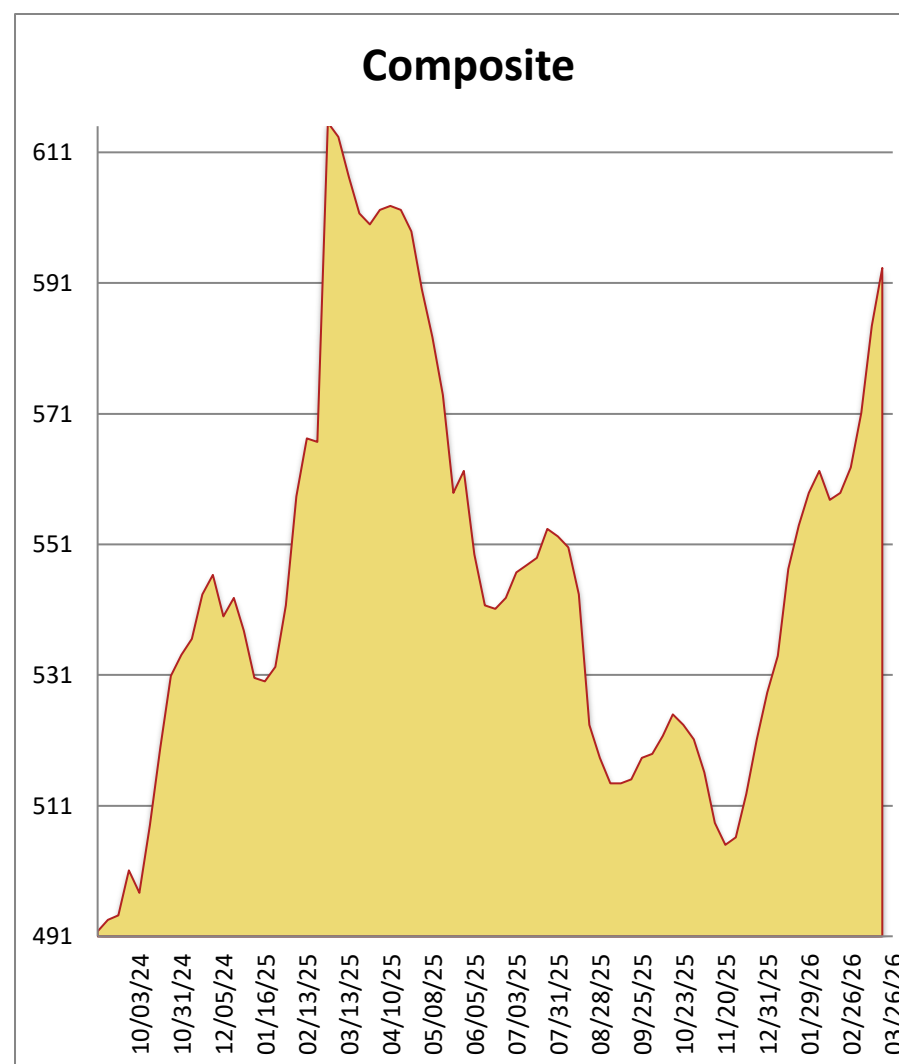

Overall market conditions remain the same yet again this week, with SYP dimension continuing to rise in price and remain ensnared in transportation tightness, adding (expensive) fuel to the fire. Once again, green DF narrows ticked up in price as mills have the upper hand on order file strength, and just like SYP markets GDF markets are experiencing tight trucking. Dry DF dimension and studs saw increased activity this week. Plywood markets also stayed the recent course, with SYP bumping up while western fir remains flat. OSB was once again lackluster. Hickory demand grew with the return of baseball late this week. Spring is definitely in the air, and in many places it feels like summer.
