



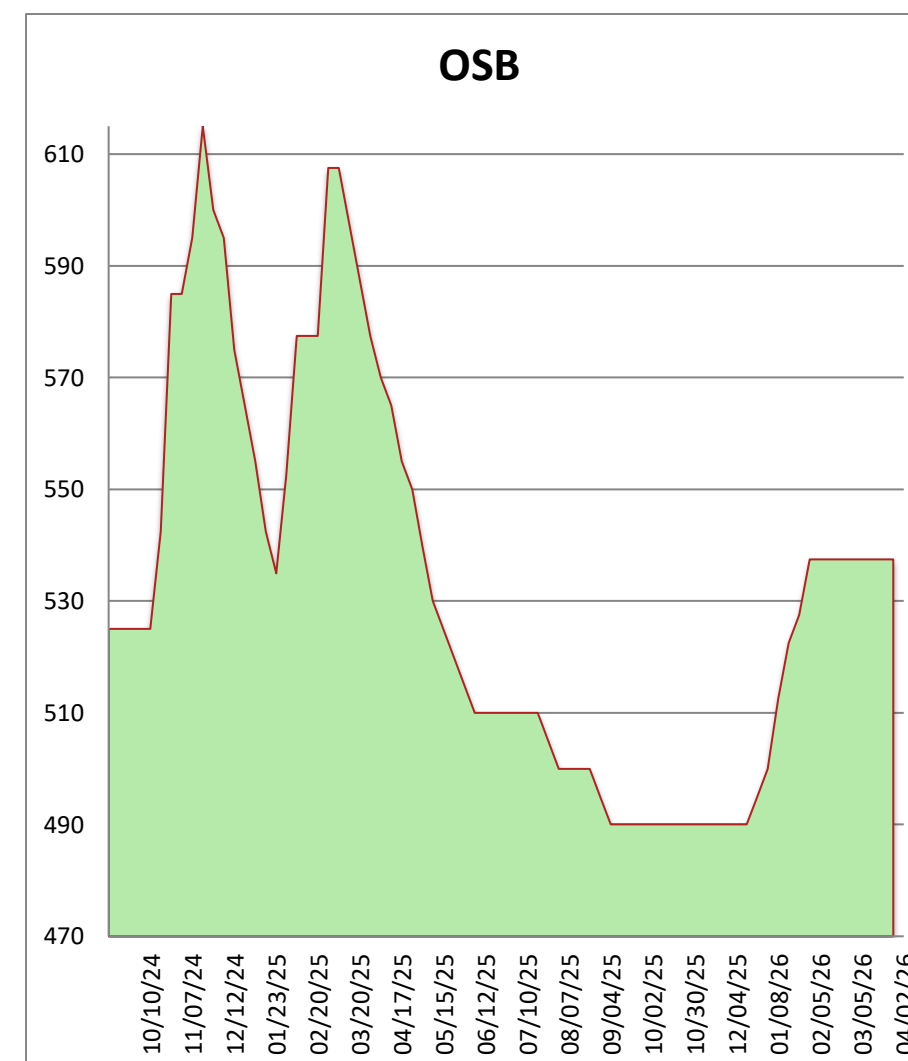
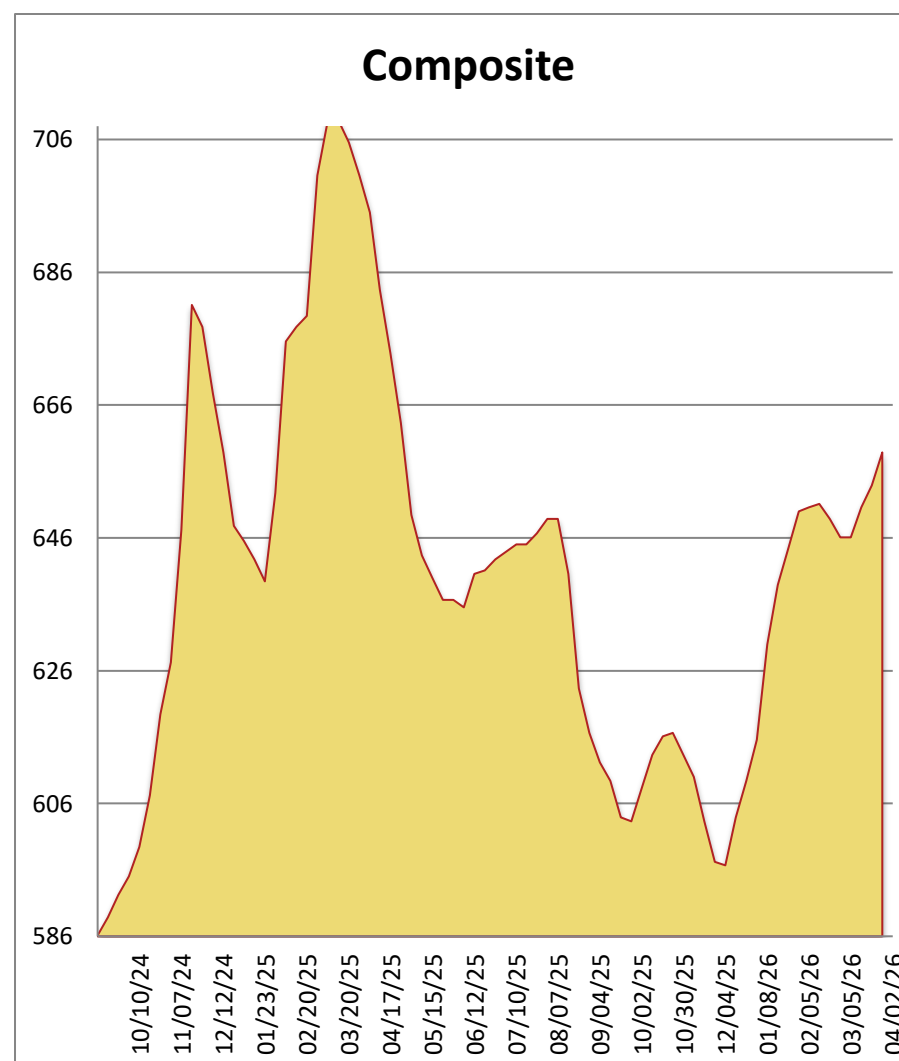

Markets continued to show upward momentum in most framing items yet again this week. SYP dimension again showed the most strength, with some of the wides now joining the party with the narrows. DF dimension in both dry and green remain on the upswing, as does SPF. In the panel world, western fir is finally on the move up after weeks of SYP plywood run up. OSB remains flat and reports of some discounts this week contradicted the rest of the commodity activity. Transportation tightness and rising fuel costs continue to plague the industry and lend to the feeling of tight supply. Starts data thus far has not indicated any sharp increase in new homebuilding, but the market is fickle and she does what she does.
