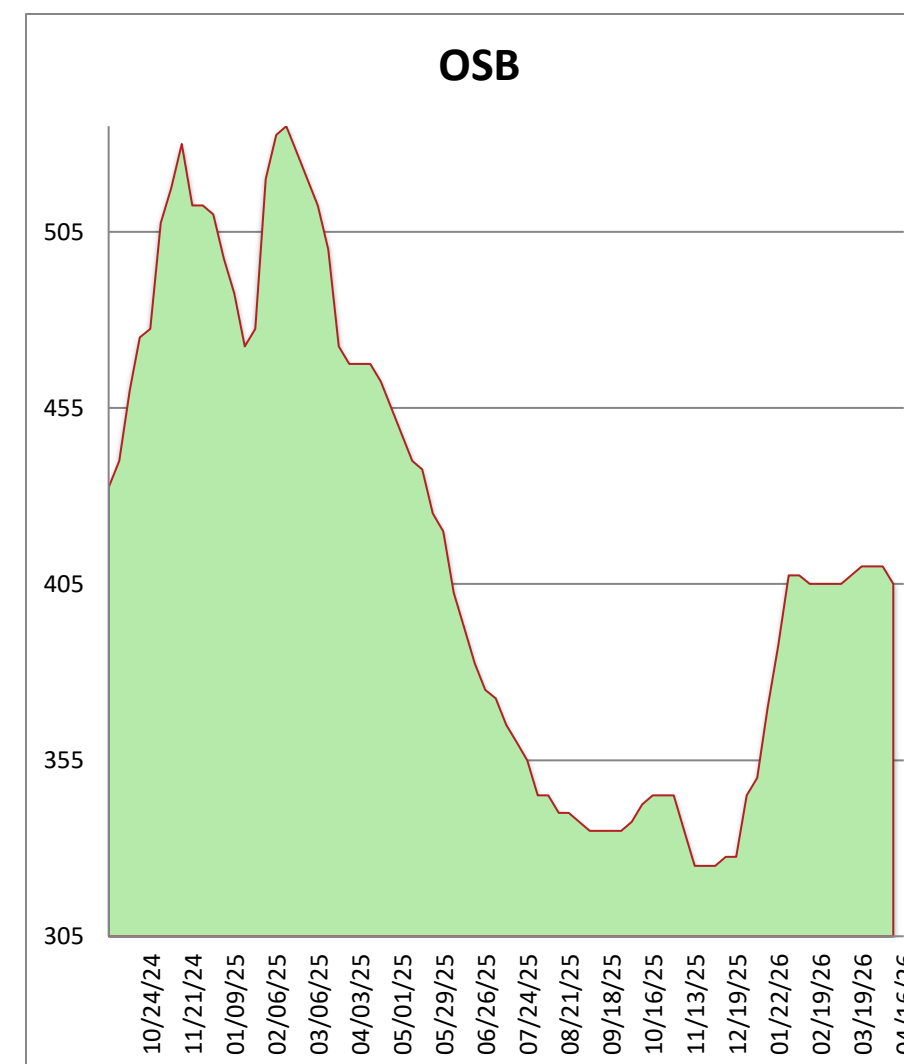
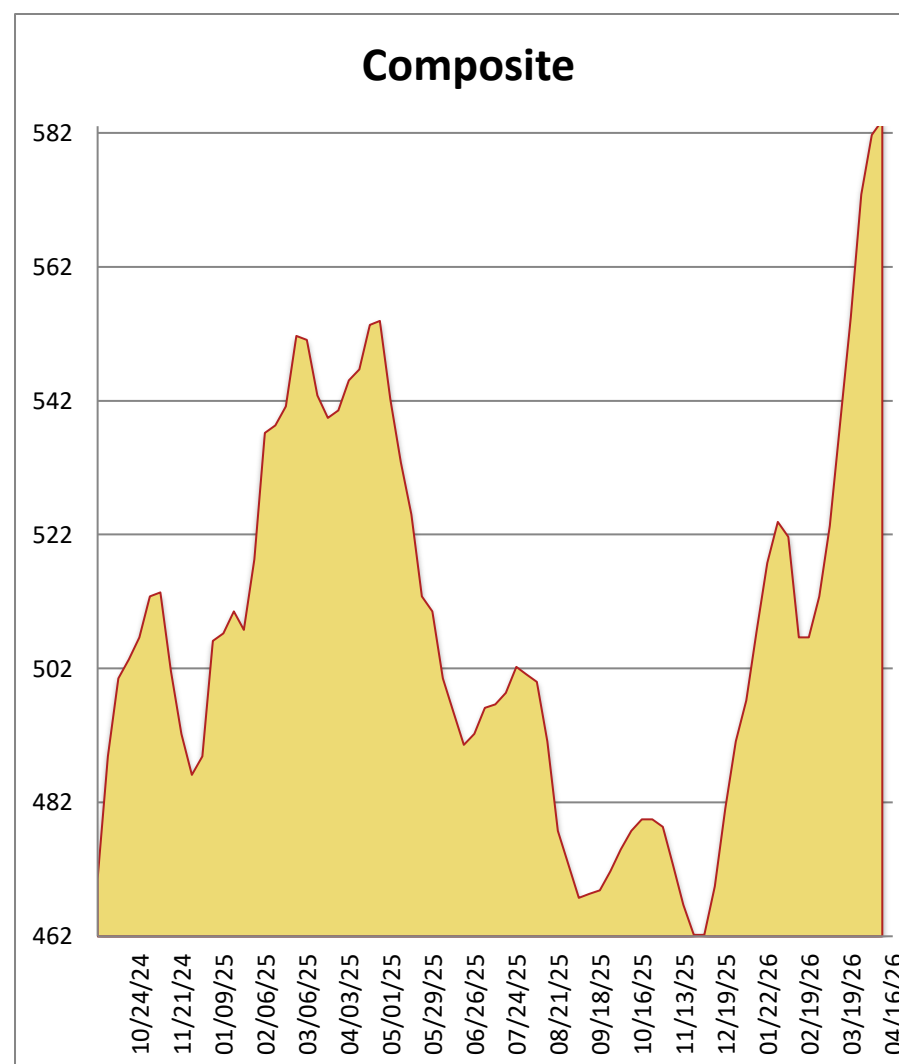

Markets remain to the firm side across most items and species this week, though the red hot SYP dimension market is showing signs of a turnaround, or at least of a pause. That is not the case with some other items, like GDF dimension and plywood. Trucking shortages continue to create delays on jobsites, primarily in the South. SPF markets took a bit of a breather as many in the industry gathered at the annual Montreal Wood Convention. One large multi-pronged wholesale brokerage company took their top traders offsite for a cruise, though rumors of them getting blockaded in the Strait of Hormuz were greatly exaggerated. More likely they got blockaded at the Strait of Hormel, where sausage is produced. Their absence also led to a quieter feel for the week. OSB continues to be a non-participant, but that could change anytime.
