



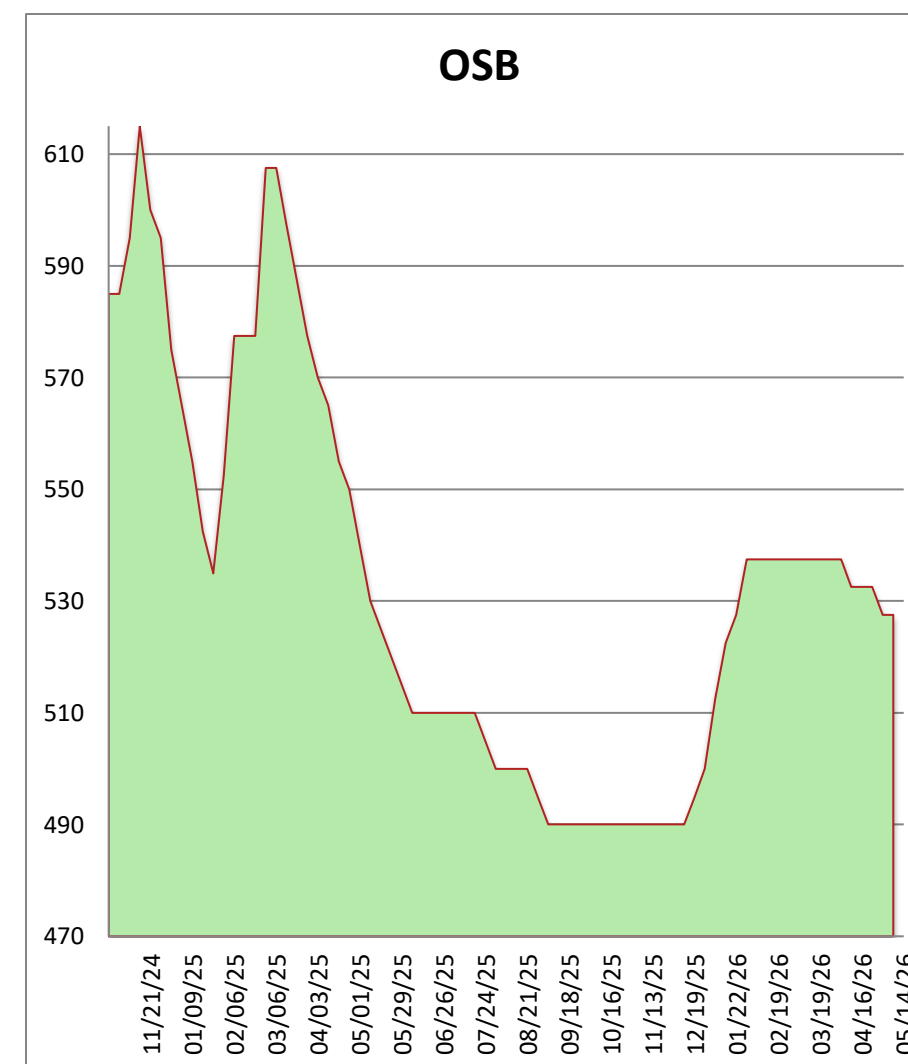
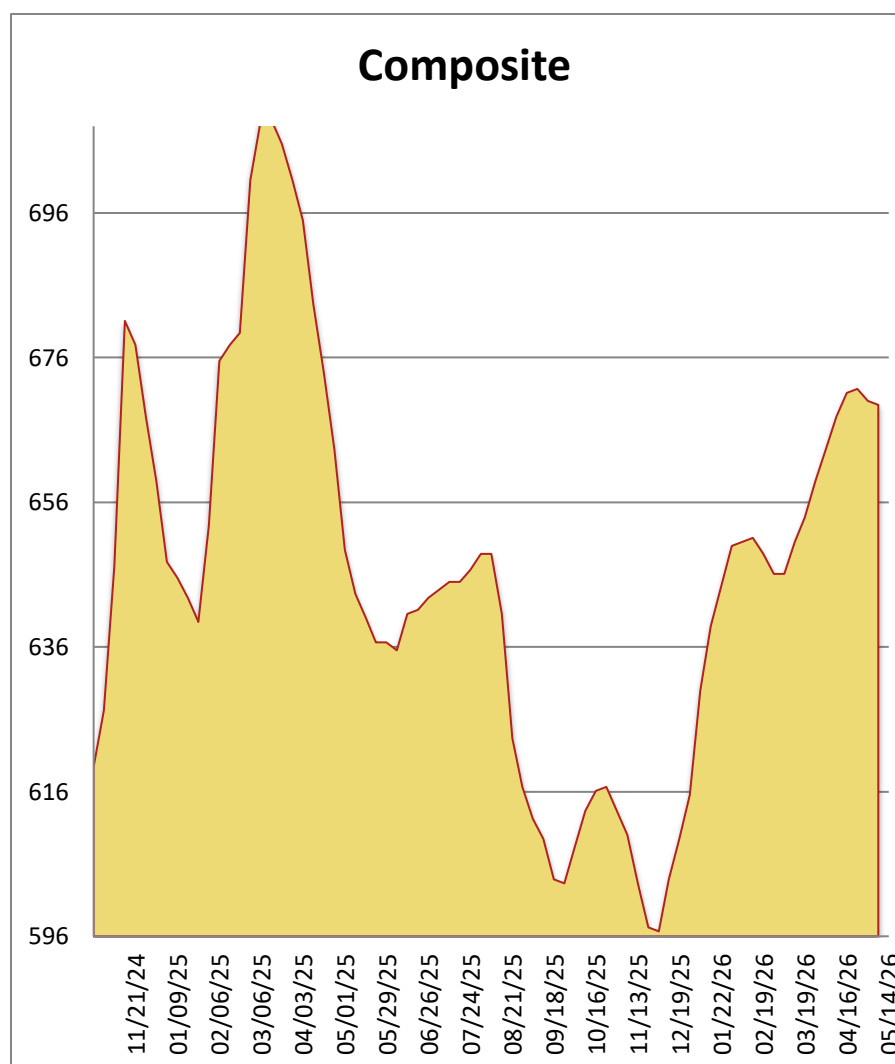

Lumber sales remain muted across the country. The downward spiral that has been the SYP market seems to be finding a bottom. SPF sales have slowed and some discounts have popped up in 2x4 and 2x6. Green DF continues to show the most resistance as demand narrowly outpaced supply. Trading in Dry DF remained liquid enough for most mills able to fend off any major discounts. Plywood pricing across the country carried the momentum from previous weeks into this week, even with limited reported sales. Some major sales helped firm up the Southern OSB market, while the Northern market maintained the status quo. Markets continue to be tough to read at the moment, similar to Bryson DeChambeau trying to read the greens at Aronimink on the first day of the PGA championship.
