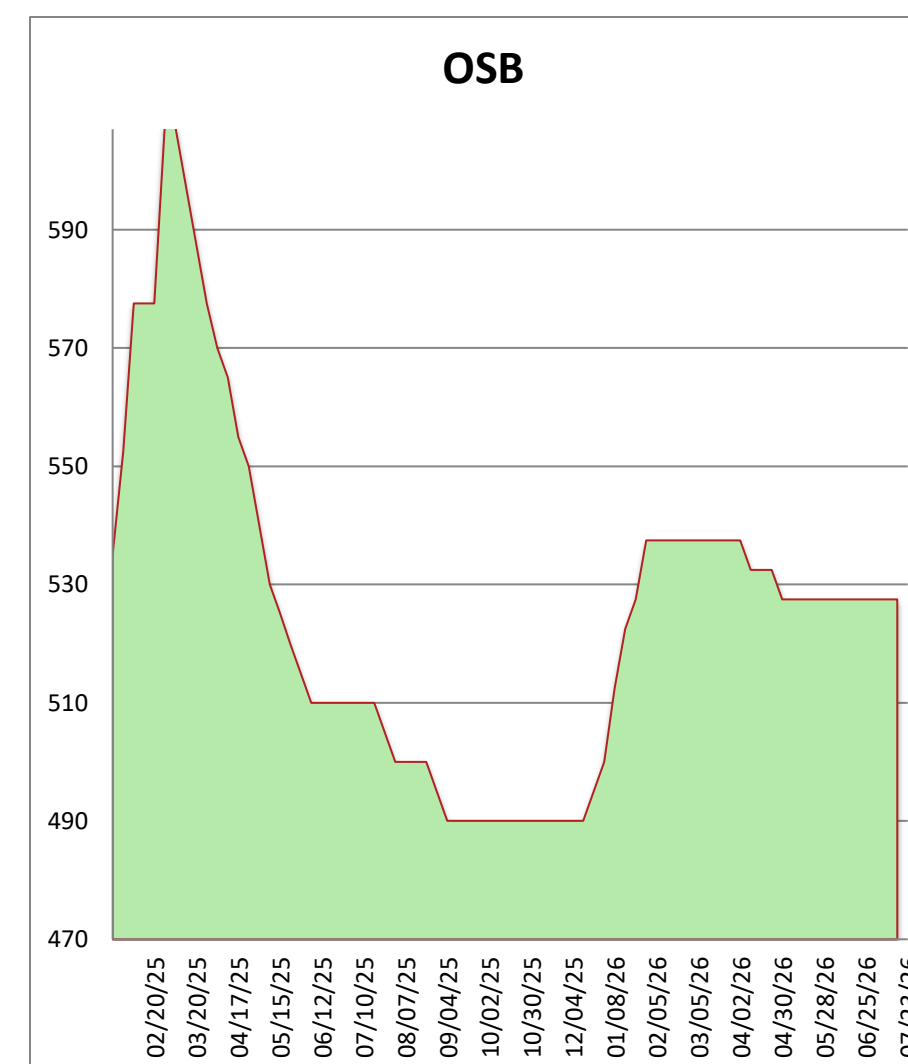
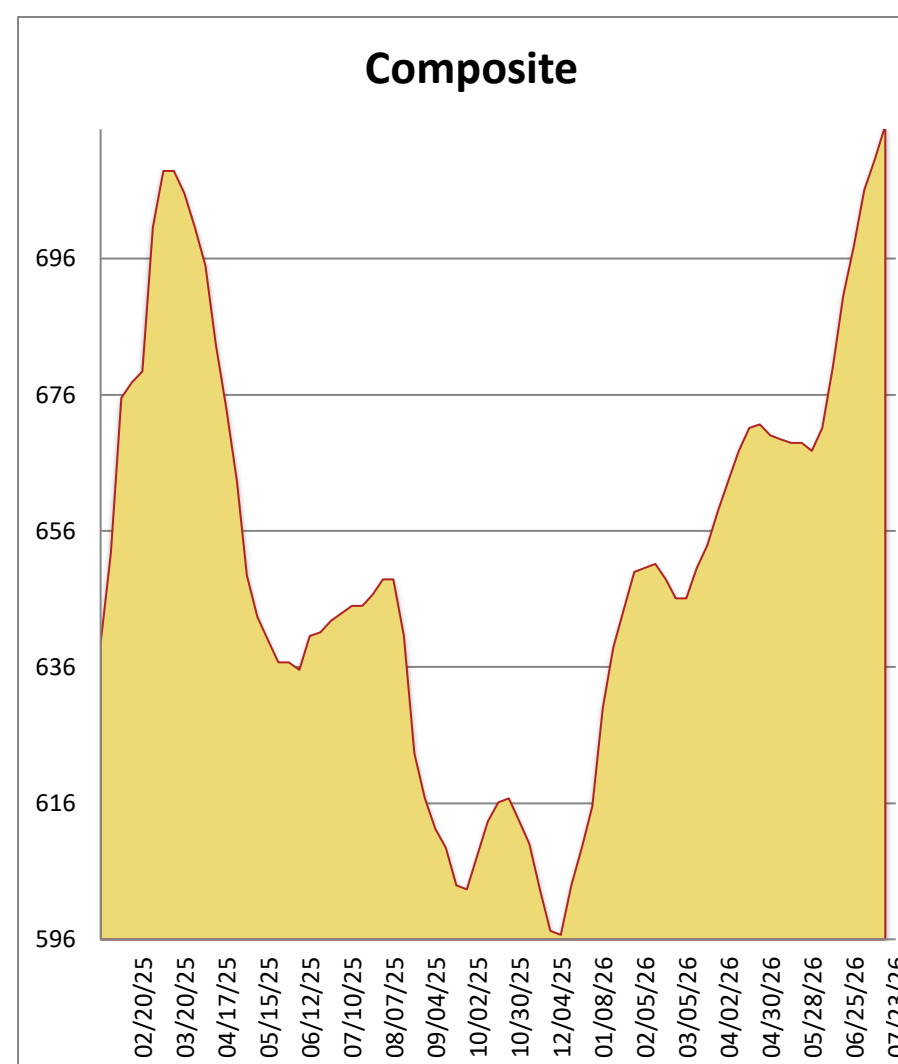

Markets saw mixed trading this week as we continue through the dog days of summer. Dry DF continues its apparently never ending climb in price, while green DF remains leveled out. SPF dimension saw price gains, while SYP dimension showed some vulnerability, especially in the east region. Another announced round of steep tariffs on Canadian products was announced, and while it won't impact dimension lumber, it appears that it will impact veneers - aka plywood. This lifted plywood pricing, but appears to be emotion vs reality in the near term. Look for more of the same as we roll out of July into August. NFL training camps begin in earnest very soon, and we could all use the distraction of another fun NFL season ahead.
